

China Medical Board Fellowship

Purpose

1. The Fellowship is for the upgrading of eligible faculty members who have the potential to:
 - increase their expertise
 - develop establish departments; or
 - introduce new departments.
2. It is not meant for faculty members to undertake post-graduate training towards the attainment of a speciality degree.

Eligibility

3. Candidates must:
 - be full-time faculty members from School of Medicine;
 - be Singaporeans or Singapore Permanent Residents;
 - have completed post-graduate examinations in the basic or clinical sciences and obtained specialty degrees; and
 - have one year's service in the University before proceeding on Leave for Academic Purposes to take up the Fellowship.

Period of Fellowship

4. The Fellowship is tenable for three (3) months to a maximum of one (1) year.

Terms and Conditions

5. Successful candidates will be:
 - provided a monthly maintenance allowance;
 - provided medical benefits in accordance with the University's Overseas Medical Benefits Scheme;
 - required to apply for Leave of Academic Purposes to take up the Fellowship; and
 - bonded to serve the University upon completion of his leave according to the prevailing bond policy for Leave for Academic Purposes.

Application Procedure

6. Candidates need to submit the completed [Application for China Medical Board Fellowship](#) (HR 024/05) together with the supporting documents to the Vice-President (Human Resources) (Attention: Ms Soh Chun Siew), through their respective Head of Department and the Dean.
7. The Head of Department should provide comments on the nominations that have his support and the ranking of candidates in order of priority should there be more than one nomination from his Department. The Dean should provide comments on the nominations that have his support and the ranking of candidates in order of priority should there be more than one nomination from his Faculty.

Outcome of Application

8. Candidates will be notified of the result of their application by OHR.
